## WARNING SIGNS DURING PREGNANCY TO GO TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM

- 1. Four or more contractions an hour not relieved by drinking 2 glasses of fluids
- 2. Severe abdominal pain
- 3. Swelling of the hands, feet and face with or without a headache, unrelieved by rest, elevation and Tylenol
- 4. Persistent nausea and vomiting (continues past 24 hours)
- 5. Decrease in or absence of fetal movement.
- 6. Headache and blurred vision unrelieved with fluids, Tylenol and rest after 2 hours
- 7. Fever greater than 101, 2 hours after taking Tylenol
- 8. Gush or trickle of water from vagina
- 9. Vaginal bleeding can be normal after intercourse or exam, if heavy or with pain go to the Emergency Room
